

The 6 Ps of GENIUS HOUR

- Passion: What do we, as a family, want to learn more about or change in our community?
- Plan: How much time will this take? What materials will we need and who will our outside expert be?
- Pitch: How can you share your idea to receive feedback from others about what you are wanting to accomplish?
- Project: What do you need to do and how do you need to do it to make progress on your project?
- Product: What will you create, make or design to share with others?
- Presentation: How can you present what you've learned with others so that they might benefit from the project that you have completed?

TYPES OF PROJECTS:

- Mastery Project: An opportunity to learn a new skill or become better at something
- Kindness Project: An opportunity to impact someone else in a positivce way
- Innovation Project: An opportunity to create something new or make something better
- Perspective Project: An opportunity to change your own perspective or the perspective of someone else
